Hebrews 10:1-4 (KJV)

¹For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto **perfect**.

Hebrews 10:1-4 (KJV)

²For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the worshippers once **purged** should have had no more conscience of sins.

Hebrews 10:1-4 (KJV)

³But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year.

Hebrews 10:1-4 (KJV)

⁴For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.*

If sacrifices **perfected** us, they would cease to be offered.

Worshippers **purged** have no more consciousness of sin.

-Hebrews 1:3 "...when he had by himself **purged** our sins
sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high..."

⁹then He said, "Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God." He takes away the first that He may establish the second.

¹⁰ By that will we have been **sanctified** through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ **once for all.**

Hebrews 10:11-14 (NKJV)

¹¹ And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins.

¹² But this Man, after He had offered **one sacrifice for sins forever**, sat down at the right hand of God,

¹³ He has rescued us completely from the tyrannical rule of darkness and has translated us into the kingdom realm of his beloved Son.


Colossians 1:9-14 (TPT)

from us.*




God's not dealing with us according to sin.

1 John 1:9-2:2 (TPT)

⁹But if we freely admit our sins when his light uncovers them, **he will be faithful** to forgive us every time. God is **just to forgive** us our sins because of Christ, and he will continue to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

1 John 1:9-2:2 (TPT)


¹⁰ If we claim that we're not guilty of sin when God uncovers it with his light, we make him a liar and his word is not in us.

1 John 1:9-2:2 (TPT)

¹You are my dear children, and I write these things to you so that you won't sin. But if anyone does sin, we continually have a forgiving Redeemer who is face-to-face with the Father: Jesus Christ, the Righteous One.

²He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world.*
