No Limits With God – 6 "God Resists the Proud"

James 4:4-10 (KJV) I Peter 5:2-7 (KJV)

- Pride is the <u>enemy</u> of grace.
- Humility is the <u>friend</u> of grace.

GRACE ? Unmerited favor ??

There is an unmerited favor aspect to grace.

*Scriptures declare there is something we can do to receive <u>more grace</u>. (James 4 / I Peter 5)

GRACE = II Corinthians 12:9-10

- God's power in human weakness
- God's power to be and do
- Ephesians 2:8 By grace (God's power) we are saved
- John 1:12 to as many as receive Him, gave He power (grace) to become the sons of God...
- Acts 4:33 great power / great grace
- I Corinthians 15:10 grace to be (apostle) and grace to do

GRACE IS IN JESUS

- John 1:14 full of grace and truth
- II Timothy 2:1 be strong in grace that is in Jesus
- II Peter 1:2 grace and peace multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord.

Grace is a Person, <u>NOT</u> simply a theology.

[Three Common Things Found in James 4 / I Peter 5] Pride / Humility / Promotion

1. Pride = the enemy of grace

- Self-centered (there are two ugly forms)
 - a) Arrogance (better, smarter, holier than God or others)
 - b) False humility (lesser, dumber, most unholy)

PRIDE = self-centered

- Disagrees with God and His Word
- Resists God and yields to Satan
- Independent of God "I don't need God...."
- 2. HUMILITY the friend of grace
 - God-centered (Christ-centered)
 - Agrees with God and His Word
 - Submits to God and resists the devil
 - Total dependency on God

John 15:5 (KJV)

"..... without Me, ye can do nothing."

Philippians 4:13 (KJV)

"... can do all things through Christ."

- Humility recognizes our human weakness, while celebrating God's power (grace) in them. II Corinthians 12:9-10
- Humility is not beating yourself up or down, but rather lifting Christ up and the finished work of the Cross.
- Humility doesn't ignore what I'm <u>NOT</u>, independent of God, but focuses on who I am in God (in Christ).

Humility = dependency (trust in, relies on and yields to God) = submission to God and His Word

Deuteronomy 8:1-4	(Israel and submission)
Luke 2:51-52	(Jesus and submission)
Matthew 8:5-13	(submission to each other)
James 4:7	(submit to God)

3. Promotion – God working in and through us

James 4:10 (KJV) I Peter 5:5-6 (KJV) Proverbs 4:7-9 (KJV)
