## \#6 Sin hardens our hearts

- Hebrews 3:7-13 (NLT)
- A hard heart leads to poor life choices
- When our hearts are hard we make bad decisions
- "Sin is never smart!" ...pleasurable, yes - smart, NO!
- Example - Pharaoh (Exodus 14:4,8)
- God hardened his heart to bring Himself glory.
- God had to harden his heart to get him to do such a piece of stupid
- Lesson for the ages

Exodus 14:17 God had to harden the Egyptians to get them to follow Pharaoh.

- Example - Sampson and Delilah (Judges 16)
- "Tell me what will make you weak and vulnerable"
- "Secret to your strength?"
- 7 twisted bow strings not dried out.
- 7 new ropes never been used
- Braid my hair into 7 locks
- Results:
- Blind
- Bound
- No more than an oxen treading out corn


## TAKE AWAY
