“Not By Works”

Titus 3:1-8 (NKJV)

¹Remind them to be subject to rulers and authorities, to obey, to be ready for every good work,

Titus 3:1-8 (NKJV)

²to speak evil of no one, to be peaceable, gentle, showing all humility to all men.

Titus 3:1-8 (NKJV)

³ For we ourselves were also once foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving various lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful and hating one another.

Titus 3:1-8 (NKJV)

⁴But when the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared,

Titus 3:1-8 (NKJV)

⁵ **not by works** of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit,

Titus 3:1-8 (NKJV)

⁶whom He poured out on us abundantly
through Jesus Christ our Savior,

Titus 3:1-8 (NKJV)

⁷that having been **justified by His grace** we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Titus 3:1-8 (NKJV)

⁸This is a faithful saying, and these things I want you to affirm constantly, that those who **have believed** in God should be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable to men.*

- vs. 5 - not **by works** of righteousness which we have done...
- vs. 6 - we are **made right** by the rebirth of our spirit
- vs. 7 - we are **justified by grace**
- vs. 8 - once we **believe**, we maintain good works

Ephesians 2:8-10 (NKJV)

For by grace we are saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the **gift** of God, **not by works**, lest anyone should boast, for we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus, **for good** works, which God hath prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.



You are saved **FOR** good works,
not **BY** good works.

God's Workmanship (The New Creation)

2 Corinthians 5:17-21 (NKJV)

2 Corinthians 5:17-21 (NKJV)

¹⁷Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

2 Corinthians 5:17-21 (NKJV)

¹⁸ Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation,

2 Corinthians 5:17-21 (NKJV)

¹⁹ that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not **imputing their trespasses** to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

2 Corinthians 5:17-21 (NKJV)

²⁰ Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.

2 Corinthians 5:17-21 (NKJV)

²¹ For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.*

• Jesus **made sin** (without sinning)

• We are **made righteous** (without works)

- Jesus **made sin** with my sin
- I'm **made righteous** with His righteousness

Romans 5:13-19 (NKJV)

Romans 5:13-19 (NKJV)

¹³ (For until the law sin was in the world, but sin is not imputed when there is no law.)

Romans 5:13-19 (NKJV)

¹⁴ Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those who had not sinned according to the likeness of the transgression of Adam, who is a type of Him who was to come.

Romans 5:13-19 (NKJV)

¹⁵ But the **free gift** is not like the offense. For if by the one man's offense many died, much more the grace of God and the **gift** by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many.

Romans 5:13-19 (NKJV)

¹⁶ And the **gift** is not like that which came through the one who sinned. For the judgment which came from one offense resulted in condemnation, but the **free gift** which came from many offenses resulted in justification.

Romans 5:13-19 (NKJV)

¹⁷ For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the **gift of righteousness** will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.)

Romans 5:13-19 (NKJV)

¹⁸ Therefore, as through one man's offense judgment came to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act the **free gift** came to all men, resulting in justification of life.

Romans 5:13-19 (NKJV)

¹⁹ For as by one man's disobedience many were **made sinners**, so also by one Man's obedience many will be **made righteous**.*

Righteousness is a gift (6 times)

We were **made sin** by Adam's sin (first birth)
(born into sin and made sinners)

We were **made righteous** by one man's
(Jesus) obedience.

(second birth, we are born again righteous)

**If you think your sin makes you a sinner,
then you may think your holiness
(works) makes you righteous.***
