SOME EXTREMES WITH RICHES

Temptations & Dangers:

- A. Poverty and holiness are synonymous.
 - Money is evil.
 - Vow of poverty is righteousness.
- B. Wealth and holiness are synonymous.
 - Wealth is godliness.

FOUR WARNINGS ASSOCIATED WITH GAIN

- 1. The love of money is the root of all evil.
- 2. Do not <u>trust</u> in uncertain riches.
- 3. Deceitfulness of riches choke God's Word.
- 4. Covetousness is *idolatry*.

THE LOVE OF MONEY

I Timothy 6:5-10 (NKJV)

- Verse 6: Godliness with contentment = Great gain.
- Verse 8: Contentment
 - o Philippians 4:11
 - $\circ~$ Being satisfied with what one has.
 - Complete in Christ / Happy regardless of circumstances.

- Verse 9: "desire to be rich..." (NKJV)

"crave to be rich..." (AMP)

"long to be rich..." (NLT)

"those who crave the wealth of this world slip into spiritual snares..." (TPT)

- Verse 10: "The love of money is the root of all evil..."

• Draws us away from faith.

• Pierces us with many sorrows.

Ezekiel 28:12-19 (NKJV)

Verse 16 (KJV): "By the multitude of your merchandise..."

I Timothy 6:17-19 (NKJV)

DON'T BE HAUGHTY (PRIDEFUL)

Do not trust in uncertain riches.

The ANTIDOTE to pride and false security of riches:

- Do good.
- Be ready to give.
- Be willing to share.

DECIETFULNESS OF RICHES

Mark 4:19

- Deceitfulness of riches chokes the Word of God.
