1. Baptized into the body of Christ

- 1 Corinthians 12:12-14 (NKJV)
- Holy Spirit baptizes us into the body of Christ

- New Identity

Acts 2:38 ...repent and be baptized in the name of Jesus for the remission of sins...

Acts 8:12-13 (Philip preaches and baptizes people)

Acts 8:36-39 (Philip and the Eunuch)

- Death, burial and resurrection
- Public profession of faith
- Old man dead / new man alive
- Celebration

Mark 1:6-8 (NKJV)

- Supernatural gifts – 1 Corinthians 12
- Serving gifts – Romans 12
- Ministry gifts – Ephesians 4
- Private prayer language – 1 Corinthians 14
- Heart flooded with love – Romans 5:5
(Romans 13:8-10 – works no ill)
- Kingdom focus – Romans 14:17
