America In Crisis - 4 Forms and Levels of Government

1. GOD'S GOVERNMENT - Isaiah 9:6-7 (KJ)

Matthew 6:33

Romans 13:1 – "Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God."

John 17:2 – "For you have given him authority over everyone. He gives eternal life to each one you have given him."

John 19:10-11 (KJV) PILATE

- Pilate thought he had power IN and OF himself.
- Pilate's sin was abuse of power.
- The people's sin was using politics for a sinful cause or selfish gain.

2. SELF GOVERNMENT – Roman 14:10-13 (KJ)

1 Corinthians 3:10-15 – all of our actions will be judged by fire.

GOD'S SOVERIEGN – Psalms 24:1 "The earth is the LORD's, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein."

MAN IN GOD"S IMAGE – Psalms 115:16 "The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's: but the earth hath he given to the children of men."

God has ownership Man has stewardship (Rulership/Dominion – Genesis 1:26-28)

Proverbs 25:28 "A person without self-control is like a city with broken-down walls."

Vulnerable (easily overtaken)

3. FAMILY GOVERNMENT – God created marriage; the home before Israel/civil gov. /the Church.

Genesis 2:25-25 Ephesians 5:22-23 Ephesians 6:1-4 2 Thessalonians 3:8-16 (Vs. 10-11) 1 Timothy 5:8

4. CHURCH GOVERNMENT – (Hebrews 13:7 & 17) (KJV)

Acts 20:28 1 Thessalonians 5:12-13 1 Timothy 3:4-5 1 Peter 5:1-4

5. CIVIL GOVERNMENT (Romans 13:1-7) (KJ)

1 Peter 3:11-17 (vs. 14) "But even if you suffer for doing what is right, God will reward you for it. So don't worry or be afraid of their threats."

Romans 13:1 – civil government is ordained of God Romans 13:3 – they are a terror to evil Romans 13:4 – they are ministers of God Romans 13:6 – 3^{rd} time they are called ministers

#1 Restrain and punish evil doers#2 Reward those who do good

Titus 3:1 1 Tim 2:1-4

Pray for and obey government authorities <u>UNLESS</u> it forbids what God requires or requires what God forbids, <u>IN WHICH CASE</u> Christians cannot submit and some form of peaceful, loving, civil disobedience becomes inescapable. (Acts 4,5)
