

## Healing “Walking in Truth”

III John 2-4 (KJV)

Intro: I know God wills to heal everyone, every time, everywhere.

I also know God’s will is not always manifested

There are many mysteries to sickness, as well as to sin. Sickness and sin are a part of the human condition. We war and fight against both.

God has made provisions for both on the Cross.

A. My intentions are to help people navigate through the maze of deception and confusion to receive their healing.

B. Equip you to minister and help others receive.

- I don’t have all the answers, BUT God has blessed me.

- I have no axe to grind with anyone or groups, but a lack of knowledge and the wrong knowledge has hindered people from receiving their healing.

III John 4 (KJV)

Walking in Truth

1. “Healing died and passed away with the Last Apostle.”

This lie comes from religious circles.

Romans 3:3-4 (KJV)

The people who opposed Jesus the most were Pharisees.

- The hardest places to get healed are in dead churches

2. God heals some, but not all.

17 times, Jesus healed all of the sick that were present.

- Matthew 4:23-24; 8:16-17; 12:15; 14:14, 34-35; 15:30-31; 19:2; 21:14

- Mark 1:32-34, 39; 6:56 Luke 4:40; 6:17-19; 7:21; 9:11; 17:12-17

47 times one or two were healed:

Matthew 8:1-4; 5:13-15, 28-34; 9:1-8, 20-33; 12:10-13, 40-45

Mark 2:1-12; 3:1-5; 5:1-20, 25-43; 7:24-37; 8:22-26; 9:14-29; 10:46-52

Luke 4:33-39; 5:12-15, 17-26; 6:6-10; 7:1-17; 8:27-39, 43-56; 9:37-42; 11:14;

13:11-17; 14:1-5; 18:35-43; 22:51

John 4:46-54; 5:2-15; 9:6-7; 11:43-44

3. The traditions of men (Mark 7:13)

What men say vs. what God says

Paul’s thorn / Timothy / Trophimus / Epaphroditus / Elisha

4. “If God wants me healed.... He’ll just heal me.”

I Peter 3:9 (KJV) .... God wills for all to be saved

Hebrews 4:2 (KJV) .... Mix faith with the Word of God

Holy Ghost?

Holiness?

5. Perverse understanding of sovereignty (God’s power and the exercise of His power)

“Everything happens for a reason.”

“Yeah, and some things happen to kill you.”

James 4:7 (KJV)

Submit vs resist / God vs. Satan

“God allowed it” (Adam and Eve)

We have been given authority and must exercise that authority.

Matthew 16 and 18 – we bind and we loose

Matthew 6:9 – we pray for God’s will to be done

6. People interpret God’s will (Word) in light of human experience.

“My mother died and she believed.”

“Sister So-and-So was the most holy among us and she died of cancer.”

“We prayed for So-and-So and they still died.”

a. Human experience = subject to change

b. God’s Word (will) = Matthew 24:35 (KJV)

John 17:17 Hebrews 13:8 (KJV)

We must interpret human experience in the light of God’s Word.

7. “So-and-So got healed and lost it ..... it wasn’t God.”

Have you ever been forgiven and did it again?

Did God forgive and cleanse you the first time?

Have you ever been delivered and fallen off the wagon?

8. Old Covenant laws (curses) vs. New Covenant grace (blessings)

a. “God makes us sick to teach us something.”

b. “Confusion over curses, punishment, wrath for sin”

II Timothy 2:15 (KJV)

Deuteronomy 28 (curses for sin) wrath, punishment

Numbers 12:1 – Miriam – God’s anger (leprosy)

Numbers 21 - Teaching? No = curses I Corinthians 10:9-11 We can learn!

Moses put a serpent on a pole (everyone who looked – lived)

Galatians 3:13
