

Isaiah 32:17 - "The work of righteousness shall be **peace**, and the effect of righteousness, **quietness** and **assurance** forever."



John – (John 1:29) “Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.”

[Two Conditions]

Romans 6:14-23 (KJV)

(From servants to sin to servants of God)

Romans 6:14-23 (KJV)

¹⁴ For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.

Romans 6:14-23 (KJV)

¹⁵ What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid.

Romans 6:14-23 (KJV)

¹⁶ Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?

Romans 6:14-23 (KJV)

¹⁷ But God be thanked, that ye were the **servants of sin**, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.

Romans 6:14-23 (KJV)

¹⁸ Being then made **free from sin**, ye became the **servants of righteousness**.

Romans 6:14-23 (KJV)

¹⁹ I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness.

Romans 6:14-23 (KJV)

²⁰ For when ye were the **servants of sin**, ye were **free from righteousness**.

Romans 6:14-23 (KJV)

²¹What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? for the end of those things is death.

Romans 6:14-23 (KJV)

²² But now being made **free from sin**, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.

Romans 6:14-23 (KJV)

²³ For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.*

The Crazyiness of Sin

Vs. 17 We were **“servants of sin”**
(free from righteousness - vs. 20)

The Peace of Righteousness

Vs. 18 We are **“servants of righteousness”**
(free from sin – vs.22)

-God did not hold our righteousness to our account when we were servants of sin.

-He doesn't hold our sin to our account now that we are servants of righteousness.

Hebrews 9:12-14 (KJV)

¹² Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in **once into the holy place**, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

Hebrews 9:12-14 (KJV)

¹³ For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:

Hebrews 9:12-14 (KJV)

¹⁴ How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, **purge your conscience** from dead works to serve the living God?*

Purge our conscience

Purge definition: to rid, clear or free someone of.

God does not want us to be conscious of sin. He wants us to be conscious of righteousness

Hebrews 10:1-4 (KJV)

¹For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto **perfect**.

Hebrews 10:1-4 (KJV)

²For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the worshippers once **purged** should have had no more conscience of sins.

Hebrews 10:1-4 (KJV)

³But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year.

Hebrews 10:1-4 (KJV)

⁴For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.*

-If the sacrifices made us perfect, they would cease to be offered.

-Jesus's one-time final offering for sin made us perfect (righteous)

**Once purged – no more conscience of sin
(righteous conscience vs. sin conscience)**

Hebrews 1:3 (KJV)

³ Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself **purged our sins**, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;*

- He purged our sin then “sat down.”
- No more sacrifices.
- Why? Because we are made righteous and perfected in Jesus Name forever!

Hebrews 10:10-22 (KJV)

¹⁰ By the which will [*testament*] we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ *once for all*.

Hebrews 10:10-22 (KJV)

¹¹ And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:

Hebrews 10:10-22 (KJV)

¹² But this man, after he had offered **one sacrifice for sins for ever**, sat down on the right hand of God;

Hebrews 10:10-22 (KJV)

¹³ From henceforth expecting till his enemies
be made his footstool.

Hebrews 10:10-22 (KJV)

¹⁴ For by **one offering** he hath **perfected** for ever them that are sanctified.

Hebrews 10:10-22 (KJV)

¹⁵ Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before,

Hebrews 10:10-22 (KJV)

¹⁶ This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;

Hebrews 10:10-22 (KJV)

¹⁷ And their sins and iniquities **will I remember no more.**

Hebrews 10:10-22 (KJV)

¹⁸ Now where remission of these is, there is **no more offering for sin.**

Hebrews 10:10-22 (KJV)

¹⁹ Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,

Hebrews 10:10-22 (KJV)

²⁰By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;

Hebrews 10:10-22 (KJV)

²¹ And having an high priest over the house of God;

Hebrews 10:10-22 (KJV)

²²Let us draw near with a true heart in full **assurance of faith**, having our hearts sprinkled from an **evil conscience**, and our bodies washed with pure water.*

Vs. 10 – once for all sin

Vs. 12 – one sacrifice for sin, forever

Vs. 14 – one offering perfected us forever

Vs. 15-17 – God remembers our sin no more

Vs. 18-22 – Run TO God, never away!

Your good deeds are not counted while you were a sinner. Your sin is not counted once you have been made right.*
