WHAT IS THE UNFORGIVABLE SIN?

John 16:7-11 (NKJV)

The sin of unbelief

Hebrews 10:23-29 (KJV)

- o "If we sin willfully?" (Vs. 26)
- "...<u>rejection</u> of Moses and the law versus <u>breaking</u> it" (Vs. 28)
 - Everyone broke the law = sacrifices for sin
 - Those who rejected it = wrath and punishment

VERSE 29 OUTLINES THIS ONE SIN

- 1. Trample the Son of God underfoot
- 2. Count Jesus' blood as an unholy thing
- 3. Done despite (unto or to) the Spirit of Grace

The sin of unbelief!

Rejection of **Jesus and the cross!**

Rejecting the convictions of the Holy Spirit in unbelief is the unforgivable sin.

The only sin not covered on the cross is the rejection of the cross.

- o I refuse to see my need for God
- o I reject Jesus, who He is, and what He did
- My unbelief overrides the conviction of the Holy Spirit

THE GRACE AND TRUTH OF IT ALL

Grace: Jesus died for our sins.

Truth: Will you accept or reject, receive or decline, believe or unbelieve?

Grace: God loves you.

Truth: Will you receive and love him back?

Grace: God made peace with us through the precious blood of Jesus on the cross.

Truth: Will you be at peace with God by faith?

Grace: God has reconciled us unto himself by Jesus at the cross.

Truth: Will you be reconciled by faith?
