- C There are many ways to receive because we are all at different places in our walk of faith.
 - 1. Some things are easier to understand than others.
 - 2. Some methods of receiving are more comfortable for people than others.
 - 3. All methods testify of God's will to heal.
 - 4. All methods are an extension of God's <u>love and compassion</u> for people.

- 2. Anointing with oil
- 3. Prayer of agreement
- 4. Gifts of the Spirit
- 5. Faith in God's Word (the Name of Jesus)
- 6. Signs and wonders (mysteries of God's sovereignty)
- 1. Laying on of hands
 - A. Mark 6:1-6 (Jesus in His own home town) (KJV)

Mark 6:1-6

- 1. When nothing else would work, Jesus laid His hands on them.
- 2. Mark 5:23 (ref) woman bowed over 18 years Jesus laid hands on her and healed her.
- 3. Mark 5:30 / Matthew 9:21 / Matthew 14:36 (people sought to touch Him to be healed)
- B. Mark 8:22-26 (blind man) (KJV)

Mark 8:22-26

- Jesus laid hands on him twice.
 (Luke 17:12-14 ten lepers were healed as they went)
- 2. Mark 7:31-35 (ref) deaf and speech impediment Jesus put His finger in his ears and touched his tongue
- C. Luke 4:40 (KJV)
- D. Mark 16:15-18 (KJV)

Mark 16:17-18 (ref)

- 1. These signs follow believers
- 2. they shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover

E. Acts 9:10-18 (KJV) Ananias

Acts 9:10-18 (ref) Ananias was a believer Acts 28:8 Paul laid hands on the sick and they recovered Example

Mark 6:12-13 (KJV)

James 5:13-15 (ref)

- 1. Any sick God wills to heal all
- 2. Let them call not us them
- 3. Elders not the Apostles only
- 4. Shall save the sick Shall raise them up Shall be forgiven

Ex. my first healing (groin – pulled) tennis injury
