OBSTACLES WE FACE IN FULFILLING OUR PURPOSE

Moses is an example of overcoming. (There are many)

Exodus 2:1-15

- Primary and secondary purpose remain under assault.

EXODUS 2:1-4 (NKJV)

Moses' life was threatened early.

- Pharaoh was threatened by the growing population of Hebrews.
- He ordered the babies to be killed.
 - Herod did the same when Jesus was born.

Early in our lives there will be dream killers, vision assassins, hope stealers & snatchers.

MOSES WAS RAISED IN AN UNGODLY HOME

Exodus 2:5-10 (NKJV)

- It's hard being a Christian? It's hard raising children in this culture? You're praying to get a job with Christians?
- Stop making excuses! Go and be a light in the midst of the darkness.

- 1 John 4:4

"Greater is he that's in you..."

No more excuses! We are victors regardless.

MOSES EXPERIENCED FAILURE

Exodus 2:11-12 (NKJV)

- It came into his heart that he was the deliverer.
 - o It wasn't God's will for him to kill one Egyptian.
 - God had a plan (Red Sea drowning)
 - His plan was <u>not</u> picking them off one by one.

Failure is part of the human condition.

- You must repent & recover.
- Failing doesn't make us failures. How we respond determines the outcome.
- Proverbs 24:16

"a just man falls seven times..."

 Success in your purpose will be determined by your capacity to overcome setbacks & get up again.

MOSES OVERCAME REJECTION

Exodus 2:13-14 (NKJV)

- Rejection is one of the deepest wounds of the heart.
 - o It can make or break you.
- Jesus was rejected by his own.

- John 1:11; Isaiah 53:3
- Matthew 10:24-26 (NKJV)
- Ephesians 1:6

 "accepted in the beloved..."
- Romans 8:31

"if God is for us..."

MOSES OVERCAME FEAR

Exodus 2:15 (NKJV)

Hebrews 11:27

"It was by faith that Moses left the land of Egypt. Not fearing the king's anger... "

 He kept going because he kept his eyes on the One who was invincible.

Fear attacks our purpose, but we overcome by faith.

4 KINDS OF FEAR

- 1. Fear of failure.
- 2. Fear of faces.
 - Proverbs 29:25

"The fear of man brings a snare but whoso puts his trust in the Lord shall be safe..."

- 3. Fear of foes.
 - I Corinthians 16:9

"For a great door has opened, and there are many adversaries..."

- 4. Fear of fences.
 - Natural obstacles.
 - o Example: Starting over, going back to school.

MOSES DISCOVERED DEPENDENCY ON GOD

Acts 7:22 (NLT)

"Moses was taught all the wisdom of the Egyptians & was powerful in both speech & action."

Exodus 4:10 (NLT)

"I'm not very good with words... I get tongue-tied & my words get tangled."
