- 3 Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh?


We are not saved by the works of the Law, and likewise, living by law does not sanctify us.

Four "R"s of Relationship with a Divine Father

Exodus 32:8, 33:3, 33:4, 34:9, 34:10

Believer's Four Rs of Relationship



1 John 1: 9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Dolphins in the Desert?

Exodus 25:3,5 "This is the contribution which you are to raise from them: . . . porpoise skins. . .

How not to boil a young goat?

Exodus 23:19 "You shall bring the choice first fruits of your soil into the house of the LORD your God. You are not to boil a young goat in the milk of its mother.

People contributed: availability

God contributed: ability, teachers

Four Rs of Reconciliation

Reconciliation – then we are reconciled back to our Creator, adopted by Him, never to be disowned.
