Ecclesiology

The Greek word for church is ecclesia. Ecclesia + ology becomes ecclesiology.

Ecclesia means "a called out assembly" or simply "assembly." This word occurs 118 times in the New Testament. It is translated "church" 115 times and "assembly" 3 times.

The use of the word ecclesia

- 1 Local assembly 1 Thess. 1:1
- 2 Local assemblies Galatians 1:1-3
- 3 Local believers Galatians 1:13
- 4 The complete body of Christ Eph. 5:25

What the church is not

- 1 The church is not Israel 1 Cor. 10:32, Gal. 3:27-29
- 2 The church is not the kingdom The church was never the subject of prophecy. The kingdom is promised to Israel. Note Acts 1:3, 6.

What the church is

- 1 A mystery Eph. 3:1-10
- 2 The body of Christ 1 Cor. 12:12, 27
- 3 A building Eph. 2:19-22
- 4 The bride of Christ Eph. 5:25-32, Rev. 19:7-8

The local church

-Officers

-Elders – Titus 1:5-7. Elders are not chosen but appointed.

-Deacons – 1 Timothy 3:8-13. Deacons are chosen by the assembly to minister.

-Ordinances

- -Baptism A public testimony of previous faith in Christ. It is an outward demonstration of an inward act.
- -The Lord's Supper A fellowship meal for family members. We reflect, examine, and look forward.

Eschatology

The Greek word for "last or last state" is eschatos. Eschatos + ology = Eschatology.

Three major views:

- Postmillennialism The world will get better until the whole world is saved. This will

 a. bring in the kingdom.
- 2 Amillennialism There will be no literal millennium. Christ currently rules in our hearts.
- 3 Premillennialism Christ will come again and set up His kingdom on earth for 1000 years.

God's purpose for Israel

Israel's four unconditional covenants:


- 1 Abrahamic Genesis 12:1-3

- 4 New Jeremiah 31:31-40

Israel's future is foretold in Daniel 9:24-29

-Verse 24 – "your people", "your holy city"

-Seventy weeks determine Israel's history (490 years)

-Messiah is "cut off" after 69 weeks, one week remains
