Luke 2:8-11 "That night there were shepherds staying in the fields nearby, guarding their flocks of sheep. 9 Suddenly, an angel of the Lord appeared among them, and the radiance of the Lord's glory surrounded them. They were terrified, 10 but the angel reassured them. "Don't be afraid!" he said. "I bring you good news that will bring great joy to all people. 11 The Savior—yes, the Messiah, the Lord—has been born today in Bethlehem, the city of David!"

I. Joy is Independent of Situations

Luke 1:46-47 (NLT) "Mary said; Oh, how my soul praises the Lord. How my spirit rejoices in God my savior!"

Psalm: 16:11 "You will make known to me the way of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy; In your right hand there re pleasures forevermore."

II. Joy is a response to God's Goodness.

Philippians 1:6 "For I am confident of this very thing, that he who began a good with in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus."

III. Joy is a Choice in Trials

James1:2-4 "Consider it all joy when you encounter various trials. 3 knowing the testing of your faith produces endurance. 4 And let endurance have its perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete lacking in nothing."

- 5 Practical ways to Choose Joy in Hardship:
- a) Practice Gratitude in the Pain
- b) Lean on God's promises Daily
- c) Speak Truth to Your Soul
- d) Serve or Bless Someone else
- e) Surround Yourself with voices of Faith

IV. Joy Spreads when Celebrated

Luke 2:10b "Don't be afraid!" he said. "I bring you good news that will bring great joy to all people."

V. Do Something (application)

- a) Make a list of things you can have joy for
- b) Choose Joy intentionally (don't wait for a feeling, make the choice)
- c) Spread joy by blessing someone unexpectedly
- d) Invite Jesus into your struggle
