Intro:

Tomorrow, we celebrate and observe "*Memorial Day*." Whereon we reflect upon and honor the men (and in some cases, women) who have fallen in the line of duty while serving our country!

I pass by the *Veteran's Memorial Cemetery* there in Chattanooga each time I go visit my mom in rehab. It always brings me a solemn yet thankful feeling when I think about those "who gave all!"

The MARINES say they look for "a few good men!" Well, so does God my friend (and women) to serve Him!

"God's Search for Men"

Scripture Reading: Ezekiel 22:30

Text:

Ezekiel 22:30 (KJV)

³⁰ And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.

God created man in His image (Gen. 1:26; 2:7).

He was created for fellowship with God.

Sin marred this fellowship, but God made a way to redeem man from his sin (Gen. 3:15).

God would send Jesus into the world to die for the sins of man (Isa. 53:5).

Through this incarnation, man could be born again (<u>John</u> <u>3:1-8</u>).

After being born again man is called to do God's work (John 15:16; Mark 16:15).

John 15:16 (KJV)

¹⁶ Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.

Mark 16:15 (KJV)

¹⁵ And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

I. GOD LOOKS FOR DECISIVE MEN

Joshua 24:14-15 (KJV)

¹⁴Now therefore fear the LORD, and serve him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the LORD.

¹⁵ And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that *were* on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

- A. Joshua decided that he would serve God (Josh. 24:14).
- B. Joshua decided that his family would serve God.

The husband is the leader of the home (Eph. 5:23).

Ephesians 5:23 (KJV)

²³ For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

Since he is the leader, he should be the spiritual leader.

II. GOD LOOKS FOR MEN WITH DESIRE

- A. Desire to know the **person** of God (<u>Phil.</u> 3:10). Knowing God in a personal way (<u>II Tim. 1:12</u>).
- B. Desire to know the **plan** of God (<u>Ps. 32:8</u>). God will make His will known to us if we seek Him.

Psalm 32:8 (KJV)

⁸ I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye.

C. Desire to know the **power** of God (<u>I Peter 1:5</u>). His power is available to keep us (<u>I Peter 1:5</u>). Note Paul's words about the power of God (<u>Rom. 1:16</u>).

1 Peter 1:5 (KJV)

⁵ Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

Romans 1:16 (KJV)

¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

D. Desire to have the **protection** of God (<u>Ps. 91</u>). God is able to guide man through all times of trouble.

III. GOD LOOKS FOR MEN WITH DEDICATION

- A. Dedicated to **serve** God. It takes a strong person to serve God.
- B. Dedicated to **stand** for God. Anyone can quit; anyone can go along with the crowd.

But to stand and be different is difficult and requires God's help (Phil. 4:13).

C. Dedicated to **suffer** for the Lord. See <u>II</u> Timothy 3:12.

IV. GOD LOOKS FOR MEN WITH DETERMINATION

- A. Willing to suffer for the Lord as Paul suffered (Acts 20:24).
- B. Willing to allow Satan to persecute as Paul was persecuted.

Conclusion:

- God's work only goes forward as man does His work.
- God could use angels, but He depends on man.
- He worked through the judges, kings, prophets, disciples, apostles, and church leaders.
- He works through the laymen, who dedicate their lives to Him.

• The greatest need in any church is dedicated laymen.
