 - Art thou Elias? Matthew 11:14, Malachi 4:5, (Elijiah in the Hebrew: why this cause he was the prophet that did not die, 2 Kings 2:12)

 - "I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness," (John 1:23, Matthew 3:1-3, Malachi 3:1), Make straight the way of the Lord. (Elijah Said in Isaiah 40:3)

Christ's Baptism (vss. 28-51)

The Purpose:

•Was a sign to make himself manifest to Israel. John 1:31

•Fulfill all righteousness - Matthew 3:13-17

•He became sin for us - 2 Corinthians 5:21 (form of a man)

•He was made a curse for us - Galatians 3:13, 4:4-5

•Numbered with the transgressors (Isaiah 53)

•The Spirit from God & the voice from heaven (John 1:32, Matthew 3:16-17)

•This had not happened to those who had been baptized, hence "lo, the heavens were opened" Matthew 3:16. All this was to make Him manifest to Israel. Notice all the members of the Godhead are present.
