

Lesson 10 - Chapter 10 and 11

John 10:

What the Shepherd's of Israel had become:

The Shepherds of the sheep (John 10:1-18)

Jesus is talking in parable (1-8) He explains the parable in (10-18). He is explaining that The Lord is there Shepard and they He cares for them; He starts it off with a parable then moves to just telling them.

- Jesus uses a Parable (vss. 1-5)
- The Disciples are not understanding the parable (vs 5, 8:43,47)
- Who are the “thieves and robbers,” (1, 10 and Matthew 21:13)
- The Lord Jesus is the Good Shepard (vs 15, 17:18) because He will lay down His life for the sheep.
- Other Sheep (16)

Division Among the Jews (John 10:19-27)

They are trying to figure out who the Lord is and he already told them but they don't believe. They are not His sheep cause they don't hear Him.

I and My Father are One (John 10:28-31)

Some of the Jews don't believe Him and in (31) “took up stones again to stone Him.” (cross ref: John 8:59)

Many Good Works (John 10:32-43)

Jesus is defending that He and the Father are one just as he had to do many times before.

John 11:

The News of Lazarus (John 11:1-17)

Mary anointed the Lord Verse 2 (John 12:3, Matthew 26:7)

Verse 4 was when the Lord heard that Lazarus was sick.

Verse 6 he about 2 days then went to him.

The family was mad that The Lord did not go right away

The Arrival of Our Lord (John 11:18-33)

Martha's Belief (25-27, cf. Matthew 16:13-20)

The Raising of Lazarus (John 11:38-45)

The Lords Opposition (John 11:47, 48, 53, 57)

The Lord does not do things with out a purpose; the purpose for this miracle is to fulfill the purpose in (vs 4)

The Resistance from the Leadership of Israel (John 11:47-57)
