The Purpose of the Epistle: John 3:1-21 (John 2:23-25, 3:2, Matthew 16:16, John 20:31)

The New Birth: Nicodemus John 3:5,7

Came by night (John 3:2, 7:50, 19:39) The Lord mentioned that he came by night; we don't know if he was doing this secretly (which could be a part of it cause he would lose his status in the temple if he was known to be born again) or if he came to the Lord at night cause it was hot during the day and business would happen in the evening.

The Need for birth: Physical and Spiritual John 3:4-8

How to be born again? John 3:9

John 3:3-7 Jesus tells Nicodemus that he needs to be born again. He does not understand, which is why he asked how do I enter his mothers womb? (4)
