Praise and Thanksgiving

Praise and thank the Lord for creating, loving, saving, caring for, comforting, and encouraging you, for providing for your needs, for blessing you spiritually and physically, for giving you eternal life and a home in heaven.

Confession

See: 2 Timothy 3:1-7, Galatians 5:19-21, Colossians 3:5-9

Ask God to bring any personal sins to mind, then confess and commit to forsake them.

Examples: Not putting God first, not listening to Him, not giving Him your best, losing your love for God (going through the motions), apathy toward the lost, not witnessing and speaking up for Christ, forgetting to read the Bible and pray, anxiety, worry, lack of faith, complaining, unthankfulness, pride, covetousness, lying, quick temper, unforgiveness, gluttony, focusing on worldly or sinful things, falling into sinful lusts

Intercession and Supplication

See: 2 Chronicles 7:14, Isaiah 55:6-7, Jeremiah 26:13, James 4:8, Psalms 85:6-8, Habakkuk 3:2

- To have renewed passion for the Lord and a burden for souls
- To boldly share the Gospel
- To confess and repent from sin in our lives
- To remove any idols in our hearts and to put God first
- To seek God and spend more time in prayer and in His Word
- To be more sensitive to the Holy Spirit
- To follow God's calling for our lives
- To serve the Lord more in church ministries and other ways
- To be more faithful to church and to the Lord
- To have more faith in the Lord and to step out in faith for Him
- To stay humble and reliant on the Lord
- To show Christ's love to those who are hard to love
- To have a spirit of thankfulness and praise to the Lord
- To focus on God instead of ourselves or the things around us
- To be more patient in trials and to learn the lesson God is trying to teach us
- To allow God to interrupt us so He can work in and through us

Praise and Thanksgiving

Praise and thank the Lord for His mercy on America so far, for the freedoms we have, for the spiritual and physical blessings given to this nation, for the Godly principles this nation was founded on, for the remnant of faithful Christians still left.

Confession

See: Romans 1:21-32, Ezekiel 16:49

Ask God for forgiveness as a nation for forsaking Him, worshiping idols and self, encouraging and condoning sin, sodomy, confusion of gender, adultery, fornication, other sexual sins, drunkenness (alcohol, drugs), abusing others, theft, murder, abortion, pride, fullness of bread, idle hands, neglecting the poor and needy.

Intercession and Supplication

See: Romans 13, Proverbs 21:1, Daniel 4:24-25

- For God to continue having mercy on this nation
- For America to turn back to God
- For us as Christians to turn from our wicked ways and live for the Lord
- For us as Christians to be more involved in interceding for our nation and shining as lights in a dark world
- For God's Word to continue to have free course
- For the continued ability to worship and share the Gospel without oppression
- For protection from our enemies and evils within and without
- For voters to discern between truth and lies and to make Godly choices in the upcoming elections

- For Godly men and women to be elected in our governments
- For Christians to recognize God is sovereign and put their hope in Christ, not in election results
- For elected officials in our city, state, and federal governments to get saved, turn from their wicked ways, and do right

Confession

Ask God for forgiveness for the church for being apathetic towards spreading the Gospel and failing to be a light to the world, for focusing on our own problems and infighting instead of reaching the lost, for not taking a stand for Christ and the Bible, for not preaching against sin in all forms, for being worldly and embracing immorality, for losing our first love for Christ resulting in empty ritualism instead of true worship, for espousing many heresies contrary to God's Word, for not respecting God's Word as infallible and seeking man's opinions instead.

Intercession and Supplication

Pray for the church as a whole:

- To return to their first love in Christ and stay faithful to Him
- To take a stand for the Lord and the Bible and stand against the wickedness around us
- To hold God's Word as the final authority, not man's opinions
- To return to Biblical doctrine and reject false teachers and false doctrine
- To have renewed passion for serving the Lord and sharing the Gospel with the lost
- To stay unified in Christ (and right doctrine)
- To show Christ's love to each other and to the lost
- To reject sin and worldliness and to be holy and sanctified

- To stand strong in the Lord against the attacks from Satan and the world
- To eagerly await Christ's return and to occupy until He comes

Pray for church pastors:

- For the Lord to protect and strengthen them and their families
- For them and their families to stay faithful to God's calling
- For them and their families to stay holy and not fall into sin
- For them to maintain a close walk with God and rely on Him
- For them to preach the whole counsel of God and stir the church to action
- For them to have boldness to preach the Gospel and preach against sin and the wickedness rampant in the world
