The Women Caught in Adultery (John 8:1-11)

The rebuke of Jesus; The religious leaders brought a women that was caught in adultery, she was brought to Jesus as a test to try and get the Lord to break the law. Jesus wrote on the ground ignoring the men and they pressed Him and he just wrote. I believe He wrote *Leviticus 20:10 or Deuteronomy 22:22* on the ground, because the pharisees are trying to catch Him in the law; but they did not bring the man that she was with. They did what half the verse said. This is showing the state of the "Religious Leaders" at the time (*John 15:22* their cloak of sin), My opinion is that the guy that was caught in adultery was one of the religious leaders and that is how they knew where to find her. Later in the chapter (vs 59) they took up stones to stone Jesus.

Contention Over the Father (John 8:12-59)

The Lord is explaining to them that He is the Lord and how He is God. They did not believe the Lord.

• Knowing Not the Father (12-20)

The Lord has been over this in John 5. When the Lord talks about the Father that sent Him they do not understand (John 8:17-18, 19 cf 54,55) This is important to understand so when the Lord called them devils at the end of the chapter (vs 44) you understand why.

- Two Fathers (33-46) (John 8:38)
- Not of God (47-55) (24,52)
- Before Abraham was "I AM" (56-59) (Exodus 3:14) (Genesis 22:8,13; Hebrews 11)
