

Lesson 5 - John 4

November 12th, 2020

The Pharisees Roamer (John 4:1-2)

The pharisees were trying to stir up something, saying that "Jesus made a baptized more disciples than John." that's a lie cause Jesus only did that to 12 disciples (2)

The Samaritan Women (John 4:3-30)

Jesus was walking up from Judea to Galilee and needed to go through Sychar, Samaria (3-5). He met a woman there and asked her for water (7)

Why needs go through there (4-5) (2 Kings 17:24) because there are a people there that I need to see. The Lord was planning on a miracle and we will see what that is in a couple verses.

The Well; where it came from (John 4:5-6, Genesis 33:19, Genesis 48:22, John 4:12)

The Request for the water (John 4:7-12) She is asking for the living water and does not realize that the Lord is the living water just like Nicodemus in (John 3:4) the living water is the born again/ salvation.

The Woman was asking what Jesus was asking her for help because the Jews looked down on the Samaritan (9).

The Lord's Response (John 4:13-26) The Lord shows her that He is the Living water and that He is the one that the Jews searched for (4:25-26)

How she responded: (19-24, 28)

The Disciples (John 4:8, 27,31-38)

They went and bought meat (Food, cause it was lunch time, 6th hour John 4:8)

Disciples reaction: About the meat issue; They wanted to give the Lord meat and when we says in (32) "I have meat to eat that ye know not of." they were looking for the physical food but Jesus was speaking of spiritual

The Meat the Lord has is to do the will of His Father. (34) This is the work of the Lord. As they do the work of the Lord, He will supply their physical need (Matthew 6:25-34)

The Harvest: (John 4:35,40)

The Lord makes reference to the harvest as the work of the Lord. the disciples are confused because they are looking over

The Samaritans (John 4:39-42)

The Jews of Jerusalem rejected Jesus (John 7:45-48). because of the woman's testimony the Samaritan. There were many that did receive Jesus as the messiah that were Samaritan (41).

The Nobleman's Son (John 4:43-54)

John 4:45-46a is cross to the water into wine miracle in John 2:8.

His Request: (46b-47)

The request was that Jesus would come and heal his son that was near death.

Jesus Response: (John 4:48-50, 2:23-25, 3:2)

He told him his son liveth (John 4:51-52)

Belief and Assurance: (John 4:51-53)

When he asked his servants the time that he was healed he knew that the Lord healed him that same hour.

The Second Miracle (John 4:54)

This was the second miracle that he did on His way from Judea into Galilee. The first was water to wine.
