Luke 23:6-9 (NIV2011) "On hearing this, Pilate asked if the Man was a Galilean. <sup>7</sup> When he learned that Jesus was under Herod's jurisdiction, he sent Him to Herod, who was also in Jerusalem at that time. <sup>8</sup> When Herod saw Jesus, he was greatly pleased, because for a long time he had been wanting to see Him. From what he had heard about Him, he hoped to see Him perform a sign of some sort. <sup>9</sup> He plied Him with many questions, but Jesus gave him no answer."

Luke 23:10-12 (NIV2011) "The chief priests and the teachers of the Law were standing there, vehemently accusing [Jesus]. <sup>11</sup> Then Herod and his soldiers ridiculed and mocked Him. <u>Dressing Him in an elegant robe</u>, they sent Him back to Pilate. <sup>12</sup> That day Herod and Pilate became friends—before this they had been enemies."

Luke 23:13-16 (NIV2011) "Pilate called together the chief priests, the rulers and the people, <sup>14</sup> and said to them, 'You brought me this Man as One who was inciting the people to rebellion. I have examined Him in your presence and have found no basis for your charges against Him. <sup>15</sup> Neither has Herod, for he sent Him back to us; as you can see, He has done nothing to deserve death. <sup>16</sup> Therefore, I will punish Him and then release Him.'"

Luke 23:18-22 (NIV2011) "But the whole crowd shouted, 'Away with this Man! Release Barabbas to us!' <sup>19</sup> (Barabbas had been thrown into prison for an insurrection in the city, and for murder.) <sup>20</sup> Wanting to release Jesus, Pilate appealed to them again. <sup>21</sup> But they kept shouting, 'Crucify Him!' Crucify Him!' <sup>22</sup> For the third time he spoke to them: 'Why? What crime has this Man committed? I have found in Him no grounds for the death penalty. Therefore I will have Him punished and then release Him.'"

Luke 23:23 (NIV2011) "But with loud shouts they insistently demanded that [Jesus] be crucified, and their shouts prevailed."

Luke 23:24-25 (NIV2011) "So <u>Pilate decided to grant their demand</u>. <sup>25</sup> He released the man who had been thrown into prison for insurrection and murder, the one they asked for, and surrendered Jesus to their will."

Isaiah 53:6 (NIV2011) "We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all."
