Isaiah 53:9 (NIV2011) *“He was assigned a grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death, though He had done no violence, nor was any deceit in His mouth.”*

1. Jesus Died And You _____... God's _____.

Luke 23:44-45 (NIV2011) *“It was now about noon, and darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon,⁴⁵ for the sun stopped shining. And the curtain of the Temple was torn in two.”*

Luke 23:46 (NIV2011) *“Jesus called out with a loud voice, ‘Father, into Your hands I commit My Spirit.’ When He had said this, He breathed His last.”*

Luke 23:47 (NIV2011) *“The centurion, seeing what had happened, praised God and said, ‘Surely this was a righteous Man.’”*

Luke 23:48 (NIV2011) *“When all the people who had gathered to witness this sight saw what took place, they beat their breasts and went away.”*

Luke 23:49 (NIV2011) *“But all those who knew Him, including the women who had followed Him from Galilee, stood at a distance, watching these things.”*

2. Jesus Was Buried And You _____ ... God's _____.

Luke 23:50-51 (NIV2011) *“Now there was a man named Joseph, a member of the Council, a good and upright man,⁵¹ who had not consented to their decision and action. He came from the Judean town of Arimathea, and he himself was waiting for the kingdom of God.”*

Luke 23:52-53 (NIV2011) *“Going to Pilate, he asked for Jesus’ body. ⁵³ Then he took it down, wrapped it in linen cloth and placed it in a tomb cut in the rock, one in which no one had yet been laid.”*

Luke 23:54 (NIV2011) *“It was Preparation Day, and the Sabbath was about to begin.”*

Luke 23:55-56 (NIV2011) *"The women who had come with Jesus from Galilee followed Joseph and saw the tomb and how His body was laid in it. ⁵⁶ Then they went home and prepared spices and perfumes. But they rested on the Sabbath in obedience to the commandment."*
