**...As \_\_\_\_\_ *Seeking The Savior?***

**Luke 15:1 (NIV2011)** “Now the tax collectors and ‘sinners’ were all gathering around to hear Jesus.”

**Luke 15:2 (NIV2011)** “The Pharisees and the teachers of the Law muttered, ‘This Man welcomes sinners and eats with them.’”

**Acts 17:26-27 (NIV2011)** “From one man [God] made all the nations, that they should inhabit the whole earth; and He marked out their appointed times in history and the boundaries of their lands. <sup>27</sup> God did this so that they would seek Him and perhaps reach out for Him and find Him, though He is not far from any one of us.”

**2. Do You See \_\_\_\_\_ ...**

**...As \_\_\_\_\_ *Seeking Sinners?***

**Luke 15:3-6 (NIV2011)** “Then Jesus told them this parable: <sup>4</sup> ‘Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn’t he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? <sup>5</sup> And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders <sup>6</sup> and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, “Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.”’”

**Luke 15:7 (NIV2011)** “I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in Heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.”

**Luke 15:8-9 (NIV2011)** “Suppose a woman has ten silver coins and loses one. Doesn’t she light a lamp, sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it? <sup>9</sup> And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbors together and says, ‘Rejoice with me; I have found my lost coin.’”

**Luke 15:10 (NIV2011)** “In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.”
