Luke 7:1-2 (NIV2011) "When Jesus had finished saying all this to the people who were listening, He entered Capernaum. ² There <u>a centurion's servant</u>, whom his master valued highly, was sick and about to die."

Luke 7:3-5 (NIV2011) "<u>The centurion heard</u> of Jesus and sent <u>some</u> <u>elders of the Jews</u> to Him, asking Him to come and heal His servant. ⁴ When they came to Jesus, they pleaded earnestly with Him, 'This man <u>deserves</u> to have You do this, ⁵ because he loves our nation and has <u>built</u> <u>our synagogue</u>.'"

Luke 7:6 (NIV2011) "<u>Jesus went with them</u>. He was not far from the house when the centurion <u>sent friends</u> to say to Him: 'LORD, don't trouble Yourself, for I do not deserve to have You <u>come under my roof</u>."

Luke 7:7-8 (NIV2011) The centurion continued... "That is why I did not even consider myself worthy to come to You. But <u>SAY THE WORD</u>, and my servant will be healed. ⁸ For I myself am a man <u>under authority</u>, with soldiers under me. I tell this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and that one, 'Come,' and he comes. I say to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it."

Luke 7:9 (NIV2011) "When Jesus heard this, <u>He was amazed</u> at him, and turning to the crowd following Him, He said, 'I tell you, I have not found such <u>great faith</u> even in Israel.'"

Luke 7:10 (NIV2011) "Then the men who had been sent returned to the house and found the servant well."

Luke 7:11-12 (NIV2011) "Soon afterward, Jesus went to <u>a town</u> <u>called Nain</u>, and His disciples and <u>a large crowd</u> went along with Him. ¹² As He approached the town gate, a dead person was being carried out—the only son of his mother, and she was a widow. And <u>a large crowd</u> from the town was with her."

Luke 7:13 (NIV2011) "When the LORD saw her, <u>His heart went out to her</u> and He said, '<u>Don't cry</u>.'"

Luke 7:14-15 (NIV2011) "Then He went up and <u>TOUCHED</u> the <u>bier (coffin)</u> they were carrying him on, and the bearers stood still. He said, 'Young man, I say to you, get up!' ¹⁵ <u>The dead man sat up and began to talk</u>, and Jesus gave him back to his mother."

Luke 7:16-17 (NIV2011) "They were all filled with awe and praised God. 'A great prophet has appeared among us,' they said. 'God has come to help His people.' ¹⁷ This news about Jesus spread throughout Judea and the surrounding country."
