1. Love For _____... Is Our _____ Of Life.

Acts 21:1-4 (NIV2011) Luke wrote... “After we had torn ourselves away from [the Ephesian leaders], we put out to sea and sailed straight to Kos. The next day we went to Rhodes and from there to Patara. ² We found a ship crossing over to Phoenicia, went on board and set sail. ³ After sighting Cyprus and passing to the south of it, we sailed on to Syria. We landed at Tyre, where our ship was to unload its cargo. ⁴ We sought out the disciples there and stayed with them seven days. Through the Spirit they urged Paul not to go on to Jerusalem.”

Acts 21:5-6 (NIV2011) Luke continued... *“When it was time to leave, we left and continued on our way. All of them, including wives and children, accompanied us out of the city, and there on the beach we knelt to pray. ⁶After saying goodbye to each other, we went aboard the ship, and they returned home.”*

Acts 21:7 (NIV2011) *"We continued our voyage from Tyre and landed at Ptolemais, where we greeted the brothers and sisters and stayed with them for a day."*

Acts 21:8 (NIV2011) *“Leaving the next day, we reached Caesarea and stayed at the house of Philip the evangelist, one of the Seven.”*

Acts 21:9 (NIV2011) “[Philip] had four unmarried daughters who prophesied.”

Acts 21:10-11 (NIV2011) Luke continued... *“After we had been there a number of days, a prophet named Agabus came down from Judea. ¹¹ Coming over to us, he took Paul’s belt, tied his own hands and feet with it and said, ‘The Holy Spirit says, “In this way the Jewish leaders in Jerusalem will bind the owner of this belt and will hand him over to the Gentiles.”””*

Acts 21:12 (NIV2011) Luke said... *“When we heard this, we and the people there pleaded with Paul not to go up to Jerusalem.”*

John 13:34 (NIV2011) Jesus said... *"A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another."*
