

## Joshua 8:30-35

**NOTES:**

**...And *Present* Yourself A \_\_\_\_\_ Sacrifice.**

**Romans 12:1 (ESV)** Paul writes... *“I appeal to you brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.”*

**...And *Purposefully* \_\_\_\_\_ Your Sacrifice.**

**Joshua 8:32-35 (NIV2011)** *“There, in the presence of the Israelites, Joshua wrote on stones a copy of the Law of Moses.”<sup>33</sup> All the Israelites, with their elders, officials and judges, were standing on both sides of the ark of the covenant of the LORD, facing the Levitical priests who carried it. Both the foreigners living among them and the native-born were there. Half of the people stood in front of Mount Gerizim and half of them in front of Mount Ebal, as Moses the servant of the LORD had formerly commanded when he gave instructions to bless the people of Israel.<sup>34</sup> Afterward, Joshua read all the words of the Law—the blessings and the curses—just as it is written in the Book of the Law.<sup>35</sup> There was not a word of all that Moses had commanded that Joshua did not read to the whole assembly of Israel, including the women and children, and the foreigners who lived among them.”*
