- 2. You have an inner being (as referred to in verse 16), but there's another part of yourself—what is it? Hint: 2 Corinthians 4:16 tells us. What does it mean to be strengthened by the Spirit in your inner being? Have you experienced this? How do you?
- 3. Paul uses four measurements in verse 18. What are they? What is Paul trying to communicate about the love of God in verse 19? What can separate you from the love of God?
- 4. What are your thoughts when you read that God is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine? How does this change the way you pray? The way you live?
- 5. When have you seen God do more than you could ever have imagined?
