VERSE TO MEMORIZE

"For the word of the Lord is right, And all His work is done in truth." Psalm 33:4

CHALLENGE

God is worthy of our praise and worship because of who He is and what He has done in the world. He is also worthy of our praise because of how He works in the lives of people. Make a decision to trust God in every area of your life and join with others in worshiping Him this week.

- 8. Why would David transition to a call to worship in Psalm 33 after reflecting on his sin and how God has dealt with his sin in Psalm 32?
