Study questions for the week of August 16-22, 2026

Getting Started

How do you feel when you receive a long e-mail or letter from a close friend? What role does communication play in relationships? What role does it play in your relationship with God? From your experience what can cause friendships to deteriorate?

Digging Deep

Read Psalm 119:1-24, 30-40, 97-105 as a group

1. How has God communicated with us according to Psalm 119?
2. What words does the Psalmist use to describe God's Holy Scriptures? What is the meaning of each? Why do you think He uses many different words to describe essentially the same thing?
3. What advice does this psalm give to young people? Why do you think that David addresses young people? (v.9)
4. What attitude did the psalmist want to have toward God's Word? (Vs. 16-24)
5. What did the psalmist ask the Lord to do for him? (Vs. 30-40)
6. What happens when we read and think about God's Word? (Vs. 97-105)
7. What role should God's Word play in our lives?
8. How can we show our respect for God's written Word?
9. What does it mean to hide God's Word in our heart? (v.11)
10. What verse or passage from this psalm would you want to memorize? Why?
11. How could you improve the quality or quantity of the time you spend reading, thinking, and meditating about God's Word this week?
