### **Psalm 34: *There's No Good Reason Not To Join God's Fan Club!***

Study questions for the week of June 28-July, 2026

#### ***Getting Started***

How would you describe the qualities of a raving fan? What are you a fan of? Give an example of when you've been a big God fan?

#### ***Digging Deep***

***Read through Psalm 34 together as a group.***

(For additional background to this situation see I Samuel 21:10- 22:1)

1. What do verses 1-3 tell us about David's heart and passions?
2. What motivated David to be such a fan of the Lord? (vs 4-7)
3. How did David describe those who trust in the Lord? (vs 5-6)
4. What are the benefits of taking refuge in, or trusting in the Lord? (vs 8-10, 22)
5. According to verses 4, 6, 15-17, what does this reveal to us about prayer?
6. Why do you think David had such confidence in God's attentiveness to his prayers?
7. What does it mean to fear the Lord? (v.11-14)
8. What behavior or attitude does this passage advise us to avoid? (v.13-14)
9. How can we guard against the temptation to tell "white" lies?
10. What promise or encouraging word would you like to claim from this psalm?
11. What is keeping you from becoming a raving God fan?
12. What troubles do you need to present to the Lord in prayer?
