

# Study Guide December 13, 2020

*Foretold: The Son of God Revealed | His Kingdom will Never End | Daniel 7:13-14*

*This guide is a resource for a small group or a family. It can also be used for personal reflection.*

1. How have you seen the Lord at work in your life and the lives of others recently? How are you (or should you be) responding to Him (i.e. dependence, repentance, taking a step of faith, etc.)? Consider discussing and praying through this with one or two brothers and sisters in Christ.
2. What areas of your life seem out of control right now? Take some time to bring these areas to the Lord in prayer. Ask Him to speak truth into those areas, and listen for His response. How is He speaking to you? How does the sovereignty of God over our circumstances provide hope and fuel your faith?
3. Read Luke 1:30-35. How is Jesus described in these verses? Which descriptor most ministers to you today? Why?
4. How might understanding Christ as the eternal king over an eternal kingdom impact the way we view one another within the body of Christ? How might it change our relationships? How might it shift our focus?

## Praying the Scripture

1. Read Revelation 21:1-5a. Offer this passage back to the Lord as a prayer of dependence, faith, anticipation, and longing for the day when He makes all things new.
2. Read Luke 1:30-33. Pray for the Lord to ready our hearts to remember, celebrate, receive, and anticipate the coming of the Son of the Most High!
3. Who do you know that needs to hear of the love and grace of King Jesus this Christmas? Pray for this individual and that the Lord would give you opportunities to share the good news of Jesus with them.
