Part 4

Romans 12:6 (NASB95)

6 Since we have gifts that differ according to the **grace** given to us, each of us is to exercise them accordingly: if **prophecy**, according to the proportion of his **faith**;

g4102. πίστις pistis; persuasion, moral conviction (of religious truth, or the truthfulness of God or a religious teacher), especially reliance upon Christ for salvation; abstractly, constancy in such profession: — assurance, belief, believe, faith, fidelity.

Romans 10:17 (NKJV)

17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

1 Kings 18:17-21 (NKJV)

- **17** Then it happened, when Ahab saw Elijah, that Ahab said to him, "Is that you, O troubler of Israel?"
- **18** And he answered, "I have not troubled Israel, but you and your father's house have, in that you have forsaken the commandments of the LORD and have followed the Baals.
- **19** Now therefore, send and gather all Israel to me on Mount Carmel, the four hundred and fifty **prophets of Baal**, and the four hundred **prophets of Asherah**, who eat at Jezebel's table."
- **20** So Ahab sent for all the children of Israel, and gathered the **prophets** together on Mount Carmel.

- **10** For there are many rebellious men, empty talkers and deceivers, especially those of the circumcision,
- **11** who must be silenced because they are upsetting whole families, teaching things they should not teach for the sake of **sordid gain**.
- **12** One of themselves, a prophet of their own, said, "Cretans are always liars, evil beasts, lazy gluttons."
- **13** This testimony is true. For this reason reprove them severely so that they may be sound in the faith,

g3870. παρακαλέω parakaleō; to call near: —To call to one's side, call for, summon.

Romans 12:8 (NKJV)

8 ...; he who gives, with liberality;
