

# God Gifts

## Part 4

### Romans 12:6 (NASB95)

6 Since we have gifts that differ according to the **grace** given to us, each of us is to exercise them accordingly: if **prophecy**, according to the proportion of his **faith**;

**g4102. πίστις pistis**; persuasion, moral conviction (of religious truth, or the truthfulness of God or a religious teacher), especially reliance upon Christ for salvation; abstractly, constancy in such profession: — assurance, belief, believe, faith, fidelity.

### Romans 10:17 (NKJV)

17 So then **faith** comes by hearing, and hearing **by the word of God**.

### 1 Kings 18:17–21 (NKJV)

17 Then it happened, when Ahab saw Elijah, that Ahab said to him, “Is that you, O troubler of Israel?”

18 And he answered, “I have not troubled Israel, but you and your father’s house have, in that you have forsaken the commandments of the LORD and have followed the Baals.

19 Now therefore, send and gather all Israel to me on Mount Carmel, the four hundred and fifty **prophets of Baal**, and the four hundred **prophets of Asherah**, who eat at Jezebel’s table.”

20 So Ahab sent for all the children of Israel, and gathered the **prophets** together on Mount Carmel.

21 And Elijah came to all the people, and said, “How long will you falter between two opinions? If the LORD is God, **follow Him**; but if Baal, follow him.” But the people answered him not a word.

### Titus 1:10–13 (NASB95)

10 For there are many rebellious men, empty talkers and deceivers, especially those of the circumcision,

11 who must be silenced because they are upsetting whole families, teaching things they should not teach for the sake of **sordid gain**.

12 One of themselves, **a prophet of their own**, said, “Cretans are always liars, evil beasts, lazy gluttons.”

13 This testimony is true. For this reason reprove them severely so that they may be sound in the faith,

### Romans 12:7 (NKJV)

7 or **ministry**, let us use it in our ministering; ...

**g1248. διακονία diakonia**; attendance (as a servant, etc.): — (ad-)minister(-ing, -tration, -try), office, relief, service(-ing).

**Matthew 20:26–28 (NKJV)**

**26** Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your **servant**.

**27** And whoever desires to be first among you, let him be your slave—

**28** just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to **serve**, and to give His life a ransom for many.”

**Romans 12:7 (NKJV)**

**7** ...; he who **teaches**, in teaching;

**g1319. διδασκαλία didaskalia**; instruction (the function or the information): — doctrine, learning, teaching.

**Romans 12:8 (NKJV)**

**8** he who **exhorts**, in exhortation;...

**g3870. παρακαλέω parakaleō**; to call near: —To call to one's side, call for, summon.

**Romans 12:8 (NKJV)**

**8** ...; he who **gives**, with liberality;

**Hebrews 13:16 (NKJV)**

**16** But do not forget to do good and to **share**, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

**Romans 12:8 (NKJV)**

**8** ...; he who **leads**, with diligence; ...

**g4710. σπουδή spoudē**; “speed”, despatch, eagerness, earnestness:

**Romans 12:8 (NKJV)**

**8** ...; he who shows **mercy**, with cheerfulness.

**g2432. ἠλαρότης hilarotēs**; — cheerfulness.

**Romans 12:3–5 (NASB95)**

**3** For through the **grace** given to me I say to everyone among you not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think; but to think so as to have sound judgment, as **God** has allotted **to each a measure of faith**.

**4** For just as we have many members in one body and all the members do not have the same function,

**5** so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and **individually** members one of another.
