

Passover

Part 3

1. Passover was a rehearsal

Exodus 13:9–10 (NASB95)

9 “And it shall serve as a **sign** to you on your hand, and as a reminder on your forehead, that the law of the LORD may be in your mouth; for with a powerful hand the LORD brought you out of Egypt.

10 “Therefore, you shall keep this ordinance at its appointed **time** from year to year.

2 Chronicles 8:12–13 (NASB95)

12 Then Solomon offered burnt offerings to the LORD on the altar of the LORD which he had built before the porch;

13 and did so according to the daily rule, offering them up according to the commandment of Moses, for the sabbaths, the new moons and the three annual **feasts**—the Feast of Unleavened Bread, the Feast of Weeks and the Feast of Booths.

Exodus 12:3 (NASB95)

3 “Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying, ‘On the **tenth** of this month they are each one to take a lamb for themselves, according to their fathers’ households, a lamb for each household.

Exodus 12:6–7 (NASB95)

6 ‘You shall keep it until the **fourteenth** day of the same month, then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel is to kill it at twilight.

7 ‘Moreover, they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses in which they eat it.

2. Passover over was fulfilled

John 1:29 (NASB95)

29 The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, “Behold, the **Lamb of God** who takes away the sin of the world!

John 1:34 (NASB95)

34 “I myself have seen, and have testified that this is **the Son of God.**”

1 Peter 1:18–19 (NASB95)

18 knowing that you were **not redeemed with perishable things** like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers,

19 but with precious blood, as of a lamb **unblemished** and **spotless**, the blood of Christ.

John 12:12–16 (NASB95)

12 On the next day the large crowd who had come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,

13 took the branches of the palm trees and went out to meet Him, and began to shout, “Hosanna! BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD, even the King of Israel.”

14 Jesus, finding a young donkey, sat on it; as it is written,

15 “FEAR NOT, DAUGHTER OF ZION; BEHOLD, YOUR KING IS COMING, SEATED ON A DONKEY’S COLT.”

16 These things **His disciples did not understand** at the first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things were written of Him, and that they had done these things to Him.

1. The Messiah will be betrayed for 30 pieces of silver (**Zechariah 11**)
2. The Messiah will be quiet before his accusers (**Psalms 38**)
3. The Messiah would be abandoned by those closest to him (**Psalms 31, 41**)
4. Like the Passover Lamb, none of The Messiah’s bones will be broken (**Exodus 12**)
5. The Messiah will be mocked and abused (**Isaiah 50**)
6. They would cast lots for the Messiah’s clothing (**Psalms 22**)
7. The Messiah's blood will be spilled for atonement (**Leviticus 17**)
8. The Messiah will be lifted up, and everyone who looks on Him will live (**Numbers 21**)
9. The Messiah’s thirst will be quenched with vinegar and gall (**Psalms 69**)
10. The Messiah would be forsaken (**Psalms 22**)
11. The Messiah would be scorned (**Psalms 22**)
12. The Messiah's suffering would include thirst (**Psalms 22**)
13. They would pierce the Messiah’s hands and feet (**Psalms 22**)
14. The Messiah will cry, "Into your hands I commit my Spirit" (**Psalms 31**)

1 Corinthians 5:7 (NASB95)

7 Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are in fact unleavened. For **Christ our Passover** also has been sacrificed.

John 20:13–16 (NASB95)

13 And they said to her, “Woman, why are you weeping?” She said to them, “Because they have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him.”

14 When she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there, and did not know that it was Jesus.

15 Jesus said to her, “**Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?**” Supposing Him to be the gardener, she said to Him, “Sir, if you have carried Him away, tell me where you have laid Him, and I will take Him away.”

16 Jesus said to her, “**Mary!**” She turned and said to Him in Hebrew, “Rabboni!” (which means, Teacher).
