Discussion Questions:

- 4. How does understanding that "all Scripture is God-breathed" impact the way we approach and apply the Bible?
- 5. The sermon states that "God's Word directs us, corrects us, protects us, and rewards us." Which of these aspects do you find most meaningful in your current season of life, and why?



6. What are some challenges you face in consistently engaging with God's Word? How can we as a group support each other in overcoming these challenges?

Practical Applications:

- 1. Commit to reading a portion of the Bible daily this week. Share with the group which passage or book you'll be focusing on.
- 2. Choose one verse from today's discussion to memorize. Next week, share how meditating on this verse impacted your week.
- 3. Identify an area in your life where you need direction, correction, protection, or encouragement. Spend time searching Scripture for guidance in this area and be prepared to share your findings with the group next time.
- 4. Consider starting a journal to record your reflections on Scripture and how God is speaking to you through His Word.

Thank God for His Word and ask for His help in falling more in love with Jesus through engaging with Scripture. Pray for each group member to experience the power and relevance of God's Word in their daily lives.
