Discussion questions:

When you look back at your 2021 in review, what major themes or lessons do you see God trying to teach you?

What sermon or series most stood out to you this year? Why that one?

What "I am..." identity statement was the easiest for you to believe to be true? What statement is most difficult for you to believe to be true? What "I am not..." statement was most challenging to you personally?

Which minor prophet that we discussed interested you the most? Why?

What "In a word..." message (baptism, worship, grief/lament, thanksgiving) resonated the most with you? Why that one?

Do you agree with the overall summary of "Cause and Effect"? How else would you summarize the year's teaching?

What do you believe God has spoken to you this year? Are there any changes or adjustments He wants you to make?

What were your biggest action steps or take-aways from God and the teaching His word the year? On a scale of 1-10, how successful were you in living it out and obeying/putting it into practice?

How could someone help you be more successful in acting on that calling?
