Conversation Starting Questions (for fun):

Where is your earthly citizenship from? In your opinion, what is the “best part” of being a citizen from that nation? In your opinion, what is the “worst part” of being a citizen from that nation?

In your opinion, how has that nation handled the pandemic (on a scale of 1 – 10 [1=bad, 10=excellent])?

If you could be a citizen of any country on earth (that you are not currently), what would you choose? Why that one?

What kind of words or ideas come to your mind when you hear “That is so Canadian!”? What about “That is so American!”? What about “That is so (your country here)!”?

Discussion Questions from the message:

You are a citizen of a country here on earth either by immigration or by your physical birth. The only way to become a citizen of heaven is by spiritual birth. Have you truly experienced a spiritual birth through faith in Christ?

How often do you think about your heavenly home and heavenly citizenship? How can you grow in your practice of reflecting on your heavenly citizenship?

On a scale of 1 – 10 (1=bad, 10=excellent), how “heavenly” is your speech in person? How “heavenly” is your speech online? What would need to change for it to go up one number? Does God want you to make that change?

In what ways is your daily conduct reflecting your heavenly citizenship? What areas of growth, change, an adjustment may need to take place? What first step of change will you take this week?
