Hearts on Fire

Discussion Questions:

What is your favorite part of Easter?

Does/did your family have any traditions (fun or religious) around this holiday? If yes, what were they?

What does "you were dead in your sins (Eph 2:1)" mean? How would you explain that?

What new thoughts or connections (if any) have you had during this series? Explain why they are new to you? Why do they matter or how do they help you have a fuller understanding of the stories?

In the message we discussed how Jesus showed the 2 disciples on the road to Emmaus how the Old Testament spoke of him. If someone asked you to give 3-5 examples of this (easter eggs in the Old Testament), what would you say?

Why don't you think the disciples knew who Jesus was until he broke the bread, blessed it, and gave it to them?

Have you ever felt like your heart was "on fire" when hearing the message of Jesus preached? What was it like? Did it happen at all during the Easter service? If yes, when? Did it happen at all during the Easter Eggs series? If yes, when?

Have you ever felt your heart "on fire" during worship music? What about during prayer? What about when reading scripture alone? What about when celebrating communion? What about when sharing a meal with other people? If "yes" to any of these, tell the others about it (when did it happen? What did it feel like? Why do you think it happened then? Etc.).
