Connect to Kingdom Work 2.0

Discussion Questions:

How do you currently spend the majority of your awake hours (job, school, parenting, etc)? Do you naturally think of this as kingdom work? If yes, why? If not, how could you begin to view it as such?

What additional/different perspective did you gain about the extent of "Connecting Rexdale to Jesus and His Mission" that is beyond RAC ministries and the RAC geographic area?

What might change in your thinking or actions on Monday if you have hope that you are Living Called in your working hours doing your actual work with individuals, communities and also systems and structures?

How might you think through building relational trust (from Kevin Hamp's message) in your work relationships (instead of looking to make a theological point, avoiding work relationships or treating them as neutral interactions with no meaning) as a way of loving your neighbour?

What is one next step you can take to explore whether He would have you live called through your work as a [plumber, fitness coach, dietician, teacher, tech worker, social media or regular sales and marketing person, middle manager – all real life examples] to care for God's people and creation and to love your neighbour, as well as speak and bear witness to Him outside of Canada for a season?

What is the most exciting part of that kind of thinking?

What is the most unsettling/concerning part of that kind of thinking?
