Discussion Questions:

When you think about the parable of the talents, have you ever thought about the Gospel being the talents we're supposed to invest? Does this change your view of the gospel in anyway? Why or why not? How are you currently investing and growing the Gospel? What are some new ways you might consider investing and growing the Gospel?

What is one new way we could "Connect Rexdale to Jesus and to His Mission"? What are some ideas you think would help form redemptive relationships during the physical distancing of the pandemic? What tool or medium has the church not yet creatively capitalized on in the pursuit of its mission?

If Jesus were to come to Toronto 2021 and tell you to go and make disciples, what is the first way you would try to obey? Why is that the first? Have you tried it? Why or why not?
