- Lydia, slave girl, jailer
- 1st church in Europe!
- I. Theme Joy and peace flow from Christ in all circumstances (Fruit of the Spirit doesn't stop)
- II. Theme "When Jesus indwells us, He makes our lives count no matter how little or humble we are."

1 Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus,

- Servants
 - ο δοῦλος; doûlos; doo'-los
 - Slave, but willing slave, servant
 - Thayer: devoted to another to the disregard of one's own interests
 - We see people do this today when they believe in a political candidate. They give time, treasure, and talent because they want to serve.

- o Of Christ, never of Rome.
- o Can we see our circumstances as allowed by God?
- Notice: Paul doesn't say "An Apostle" like in other letters.
 - No need to defend his apostleship to the Philippians. They didn't challenge his apostolic authority.

To all the saints in Christ Jesus who are at Philippi, with the overseers and deacons:

- the saints if you are in Christ, you are a "Saint"
 - o Set apart for God, special, purpose
- overseers and deacons 1st mention in NT
 - O <u>Overseer</u> <u>ἐπίσκοπος</u>, Ερίskopos ep-is'-kop-os
 - bishop, overseer, elder
 - A synonymous term= Presbyter πρεσβύτερος: Presbýteros; presboo'-ter-os –Elder, presiding over
 - Deacons διάκονος; Diákonos; dee-ak'-on-os
 - servant, minister, a person who renders service and help to others, in some a trusted officer of helps and service in the local church
 - Additional office (Not mentioned here): Pastor: ποιμήν: poimén; poy-mane' shepherd, pastor.
- ² Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - Grace always 1st! Then Peace.
 - o The Roman greeting would be: "Charis" (Grace), the Jewish is: "Shalom" (Peace)
- ³ I thank <u>my God</u> in all <u>my remembrance of you</u>, ⁴ always in every prayer of mine for you all making my <u>prayer with joy</u>,
 - my God Paul could claim this.
 - o Paul served the Lord with all his heart.
 - o The Lord was his 1st priority, i.e. "his God"
 - Paul will later contrast the enemies of the cross of Christ as those whose god is their bellies/ stomach – meaning their mind is on themselves and not the Spirit-led things of God, <u>Philippians 3:19</u>
 - Remembrance Fond memories of the church at Philippi
 - They were beaten publicly, falsely accused, and imprisoned, yet it led to the jailer and his whole house being saved!
 - of you— This can be a great prayer starter.
 - o Thank the Lord for the godly people/influences that He brought into your life.



You might be surprised where the Spirit takes you.

⁵ because of your <u>partnership in the gospel</u> from the first day until now.

- partnership in the gospel–Fellowship" is *koinonia*
 - o The Philippian church sent a gift to Paul by Epaphroditus Philippians 4:18
 - o They also sent many gifts to Paul for his work at various times.
 - Jesus did the heavy work of gaining our salvation; however, we can partner in that work by helping to get the message out, assisting a messenger, praying for the work, inviting someone to church,
 - o This is a recurring theme in this letter
 - Sometimes it's difficult: <u>Philippians 3:10</u> –that I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may <u>share</u> his sufferings, becoming like him in his death,

⁶ And I am sure of this, that <u>he who began a good work in you</u> will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.

- He who began a good work in you God found us, we didn't find Him
 - o He started a work in us which continues even now through sanctification
 - As a songwriter, I will start on a song and work out the melody, harmony, and rhythm, and then record and often rerecord parts until it's correct. Then I will mix until it is correct. Then I will master the song until I feel good about the work. Then, and only then, will I release it for the public to hear my work. There are songs I have given up on because I am not perfect and couldn't get them correct. God is Perfect and can not fail!
 - He began a work in us and he will reveal the finished product on the day of Christ Jesus!
 - We will be blameless, perfect, and RIGHTEOUS!
 - The whole creation waits for this! Rom 8:19^{CEB} The whole creation waits breathless with anticipation for the revelation of God's sons and daughters.
 - MARK MY WORDS, the day is coming! We will be complete in HIM!
