

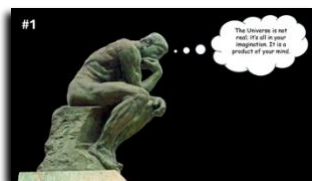
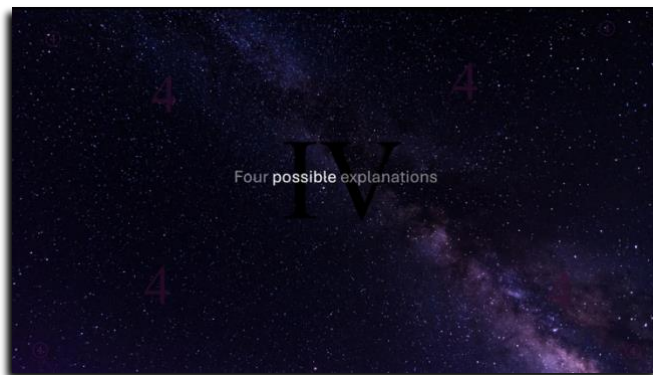
- **INTRO to Genesis**

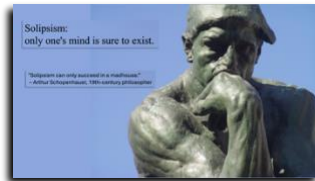

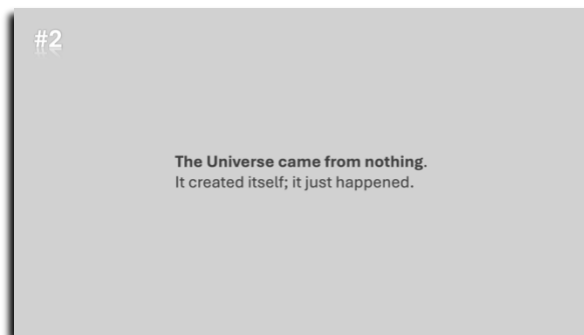
- **Four** possible explanations for the universe

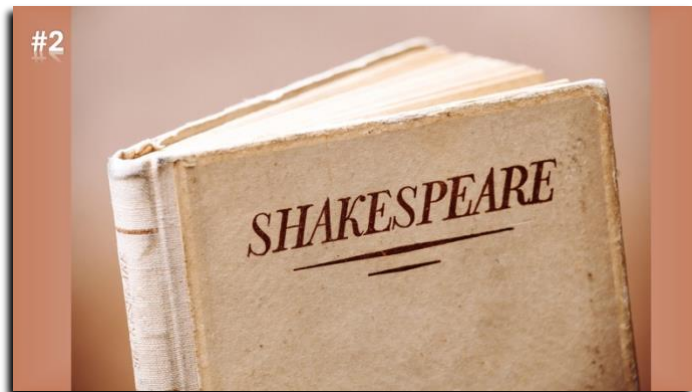

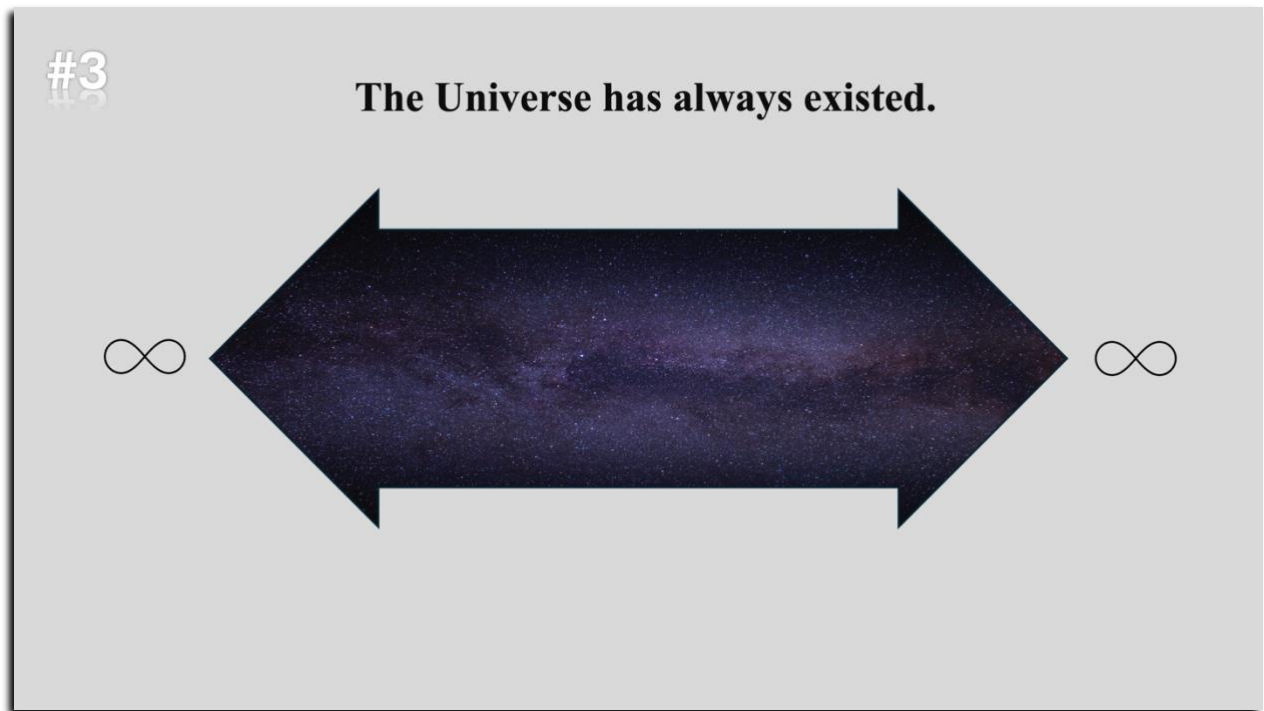


- A Chef= A meal; A builder/designer =a house; A drummer

- To believe that randomness created everything is like believing a bomb strapped to a Webster's dictionary could create Shakespeare.

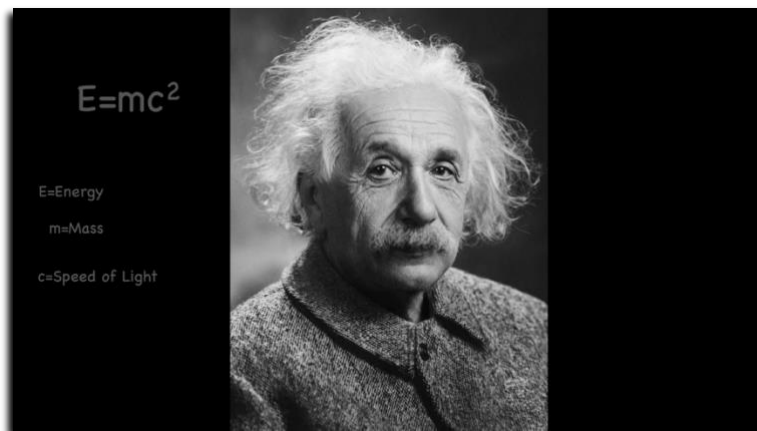
- A very large number of people subscribe to this idea. 😬



#3) The Universe has always existed.

- This was the majority belief 100 years ago by sceptics of the Bible.
- This violates 2nd law of Thermo-dynamics (Physics)
 - **1st Law** - Energy cannot be created or destroyed. It only changes form or transfers from one object to another.
 - **2nd Law** - States that in any energy transfer or transformation, the total entropy of an isolated system can never decrease over time, meaning that heat naturally flows from hot to cold objects and not the other way around.
 - **Entropy: A Measure of disorder**

- Heat loss
 - If the Universe existed for eternity, it would have died an eternity ago from heat loss.



- **Einstein** reportedly referred to his failure to accept the validation of his equations—when they had predicted the expansion of the universe in theory, before it was demonstrated in observation of the cosmological [redshift](#)—as his "biggest blunder"



- In


1929, not long after Einstein developed his static theory, observations by [Edwin Hubble](#) indicated that the universe appears to be expanding

- **#4) There is an Un-Caused 1st cause** of everything.
 - A cause that is infinite
- Has this “Un-caused 1st cause” communicated anything?
 - The foundation of all theology is: God is.
 - **General Revelation**– Available to everyone at all times
 - [Psalm 19:1-4](#) – ¹ *The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork. ² Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge. ³ There is no speech, nor are there words, whose voice is not heard. ⁴ Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world.*
 - [Romans 1:18-20](#) ²⁰ *For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse*

- **Special Revelation**– Adam Harwood describes it as, “Available to some people, but not all people. The means of special revelation includes divine speech, prophecy, dreams and visions, divine or angelic appearances, signs and miracles, the incarnation of Christ, and Scripture.”³

- The Bible
 - [Hebrews 1:2](#)
 - MAPS: Manuscripts/Archaeology/Prophecy/Statistics
 - **Manuscripts**
 - The largest collection of manuscripts of all works
 - Sir Frederic Kenyon, director and principal librarian of the British Museum, said: *No other ancient book has anything like such early and plentiful testimony to its text, and no unbiased scholar would deny that the text that has come down to us is substantially sound*”
 - **Archaeology**
 - Digs prove the Bible correct. (I usually flip it to say the Bible verifies archaeology)
 - **Prophecy**

- Over 1/3 prophecy and all have happened, except future ones
- Statistics
 - more than 40 authors over about 1600 years (one book, not a collection)
 - Authors were kings, peasants, philosophers, fishermen, physician, tax collector, statesmen, scholars, poets and farmers.
 - Written from Italy, Greece, Babylon, Persia, and Israel. The human authors lived in different cultures and had different experiences. They were different in character and personality.
 - 3 languages; Old Testament: Hebrew; Aramaic; New Testament: Greek.
 - Continuity and unity from Genesis to Revelation.
- Internal testimony
 -  2 Timothy 3:16-17 – ¹⁶ *All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,* ¹⁷ *that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.*

- **Romans 3:2** *Then what advantage has the Jew? Or what is the value of circumcision? Much in every way. To begin with, the Jews were entrusted with **the oracles of God.***
 - Theopneustos “God-breathed”.
 - Only here NT
