- We spoke about Jacob, however, lets back up and address some other “side roads.”

John 1:18 – ¹⁸ No one has ever seen God; God the only Son, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.

 - [Genesis 18:1](#)
 - ²⁷ Abraham answered and said, “Behold, I have undertaken to speak to the Lord, I who am but dust and ashes. ²⁸ Suppose five of the fifty righteous are lacking. Will you destroy the whole city for lack of five?” And he said, “I will not destroy it if I find forty-five there.” ²⁹ Again he spoke to him and said, “Suppose forty are found there.” He answered, “For the sake of forty I will not do it.” ³⁰ Then he said, “Oh let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak. Suppose thirty are found there.” He answered, “I will not do it, if I find thirty there.” ³¹ He said, “Behold, I have undertaken to speak to the Lord. Suppose twenty are found there.” He answered, “For the sake of twenty I will not destroy it.” ³² Then he said, “Oh let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak again but this once. Suppose ten are found there.” He answered, “For the sake of ten I will not destroy it.” ³³ And the Lord went his way, when he had finished speaking to Abraham, and Abraham returned to his place.
 - Abraham recognized and acknowledged this one as God
 - Moses in the narration recognizes Him with **LORD**
- **Jacob** and the man [Genesis 32:28-30](#)
 - Jacob sees God (**Christophany**) [Genesis 32:28-30](#) –²⁸ Then he said, “Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel, for you have striven with God and with men, and have prevailed.” ²⁹ Then Jacob asked him, “Please tell me your name.” But he said, “Why is it that you ask my name?” And there he blessed him. ³⁰ So Jacob called the name of the place Peniel, saying, “For I have seen God face to face, and yet my life has been delivered.”

- Exodus
 - Moses –
 - [Exodus 3:1-2, 14](#) – *Now Moses was keeping the flock of his father-in-law, Jethro, the priest of Midian, and he led his flock to the west side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. ² And **the angel of the Lord** appeared to him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush. He looked, and behold, the bush was burning, yet it was not consumed.*
 - [Exodus 3:14 IAM](#) – ¹⁴ *God said to Moses, “I am who I am.” And he said, “Say this to the people of Israel: ‘I am has sent me to you.’”*
 - [Exodus 33:18-23](#) – ¹⁸ *Moses said, “Please **show me your glory.**” ¹⁹ And he said, “I will make all my goodness pass before you and will proclaim before you my name ‘The Lord.’ And I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy. ²⁰ But,” he said, “you cannot see my face, for man shall not see me and live.” ²¹ And the Lord said, “Behold, there is a place by me **where you shall stand on the rock,** ²² and while my glory passes by I will put you **in a cleft of the rock,** and I will cover you **with my hand** until I have passed by. ²³ Then I will take away my hand, and you shall see my back, but my face shall not be seen.”*
 - **Right hand:** [Psalm 89:13](#) – *You have a **mighty arm**; strong is your **hand**, high your **right hand**.*
 - [Isaiah 62:8](#) – *The Lord has sworn by his **right hand** and by his **mighty arm**: “I will not again give your grain to be food for your enemies, and foreigners shall not drink your wine for which you have labored;*
 - [Hebrews 1:3](#) – ***He** is **the** radiance of **the** glory of God and **the** exact imprint of his nature, and **he** upholds **the** universe by **the** word of his power. After making purification for sins, **he sat down at the right hand** of **the** Majesty on high,*
 - [Hebrews 10:12](#) – *But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, **he sat down at the right hand** of God,*
