¹⁸ Whenever the LORD raised up judges for them, the LORD was with the judge, and he saved them from the hand of their enemies... ¹⁹ But whenever the judge died, they turned back and were more corrupt than their fathers... ²⁵ In those days there was no king in Israel. Everyone did what was right in his own eyes.

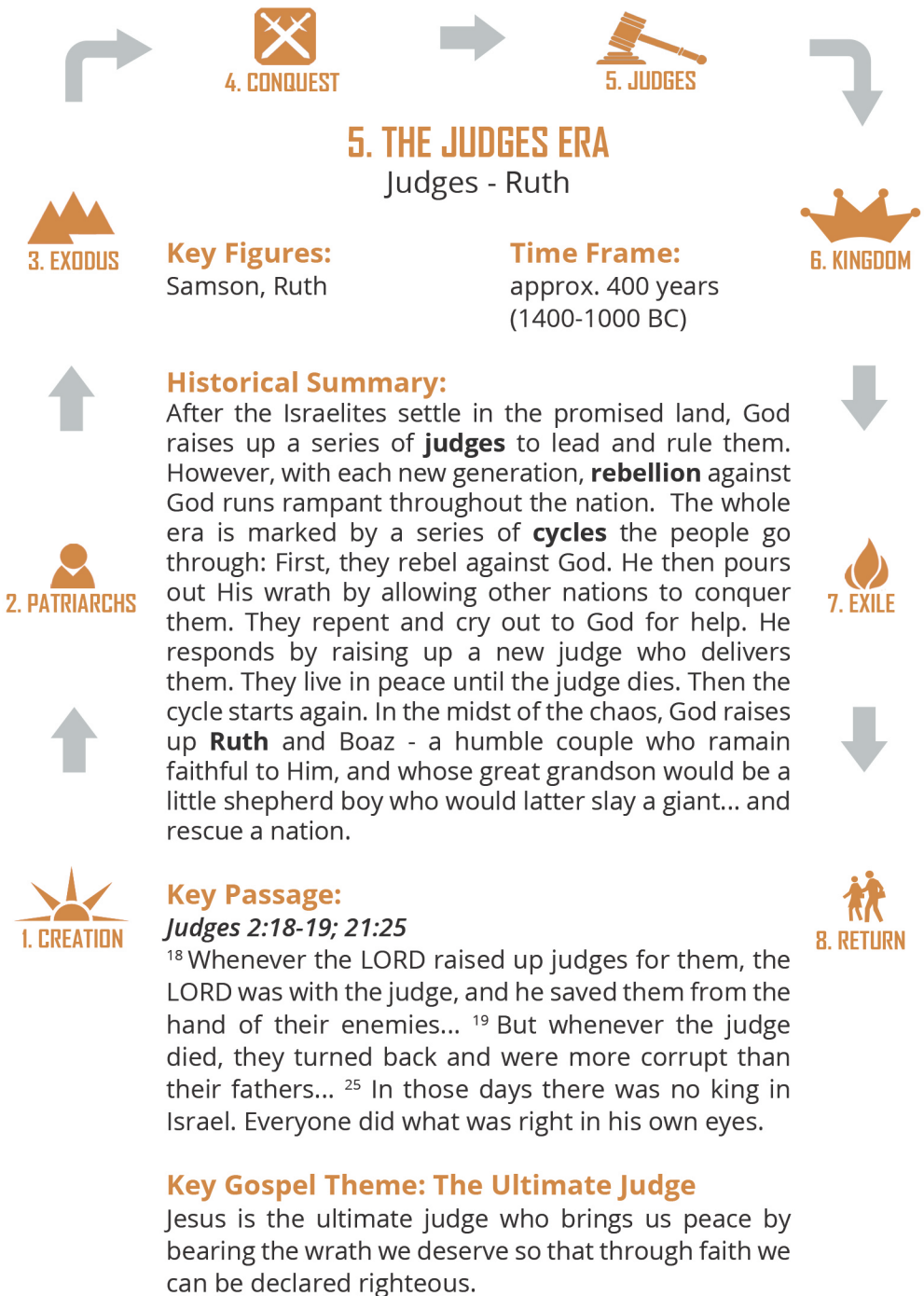
