Text: Romans 8:31-39

Context - Paul has taken us through Justification in Romans 3:21-5:21, Sanctification in 6:1-8:11, and now Glorification in Romans 8:12-39.

Allow God's unstoppable love to help you...

I. _____ against all accusations (vs. 31-34)

- A. "It is just as futile for anyone to lay a charge against us as it is to lay a charge against Christ, because we are clothed in his righteousness... Once the supreme, sovereign judge declares us righteous in his sight, all the slander in the world can make no impact on God's assured, final judgment." (R.C. Sproul Devotional: None Can Condemn)
- B. "The justice of God has not a word to say against the Christian; on the contrary, justice is well content to confirm the saving decree; for, says Justice, 'That sinner owes me nothing—Christ has discharged his debts; I will not put that sinner in prison—I have no right to do so, for Christ was imprisoned instead of him.'" (Charles H. Spurgeon (Sermon: God is With Us)

II. _____ against all enemies (vs. 35-39)

- A. "The reason Paul can say that nothing will separate us from the love of Christ is because Christ is alive and is still loving us now. He is at the right hand of God and is therefore ruling for us. And he is interceding for us, which means he is seeing to it that his finished work of redemption does in fact save us hour by hour and bring us safe to eternal joy." (John Piper (Sermon: Nothing Can Separate Us from the Love of Christ)
- B. "Thank God my salvation doesn't depend on me tonight, but on God's love of me. Not my feeble, frail grasp of him, but thy strong grasp of me." (Martyn Lloyd-Jones (Sermon: More Than Conquerors)
