Text: Genesis 24

Context - After Sarah's death and burial in Genesis 23, Genesis 24 follows Abraham's quest to secure a godly wife for Isaac, showcasing his faith in God's provision and guidance for the next generation's covenant legacy.

As you seek the Lord for the needs in your life...

I. _____ by the principles (vs. 1-9)

- A. Abraham knew his son needed a wife, and he would not allow for him to marry any of the pagan Canaanite women. Abraham was trusting God to provide a wife for his son.
- B. We may not know when or how God will provide, but we must abide in his principles and trust him for his timing.

II. _____ in prayer. (Vs. 10-21)

- A. The servant is sent out with a tall task, and he immediately begins to pray for God to provide a suitable mate for Isaac. Before he was finished praying, God was already at work with an answer.
- B. We must not neglect to ask in prayer for the needs of our lives. All things are possible with God.

III. _____ the provisions. (Vs. 22-67)

- A. This passage is filled with the provisions of God. God provided water for the servant and the camels (vs. 18-19), lodging for the servant (vs. 25), a wife for Isaac (vs. 51), and comfort for Isaac (vs. 67).
- B. God will always provide for our needs. What provisions of God can you be thankful for today?
