- 1. Be honest about where you are.
- You can get lost because of <u>drifting</u>.

• You can get lost because of rebelling.

The people of Israel feed on the wind; they chase after the east wind all day long.

They pile up lies and violence; (Hosea 12:1a, NLT)

This is what the Lord says: "Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls." But you said, 'We will not walk in it.' (Jeremiah 6:16, NIV)

2. Stop and **Get Directions**.
