- -Reject <u>factious</u> people "Warn a divisive person once, and then warn him a second time. After that, have nothing to do with him. You may be sure that such a man is warped and sinful; he is self-condemned." (Titus 3:10-11)

- Good works illustrated in <u>relationships</u> "As soon as I send Artemas or Tychicus to you, do your best to come to me at Nicopolis, because I have decided to winter there." (**Titus 3:12**)
  - They used their time.
- -Good Works illustrated in <u>Ministry</u> "Do everything you can to help Zenas the lawyer and Apollos on their way and see that they have everything they need." (Titus 3:13)
  - They used their talents.
  - They used their treasures.

Our people must learn to devote themselves to doing what is good, in order that they may provide for daily necessities and not live unproductive lives. (**Titus 3:14**)
